

## Clear Creek School District

The Clear Creek School District was established in 1922 from the territory taken from the Happy Camp District. The school house, built entirely of redwood lumber brought from the coast, was located at Ferry Point - approximately two and half miles south of Clear Creek on highway 96. There is no trace of the building left. The district was lapsed and then included in the Dillon District in 1943.

School opened for the 1923-1924 school term with Mr. Walter Stone as the teacher. The last teacher was A.A. Morgan in 1941-1942.

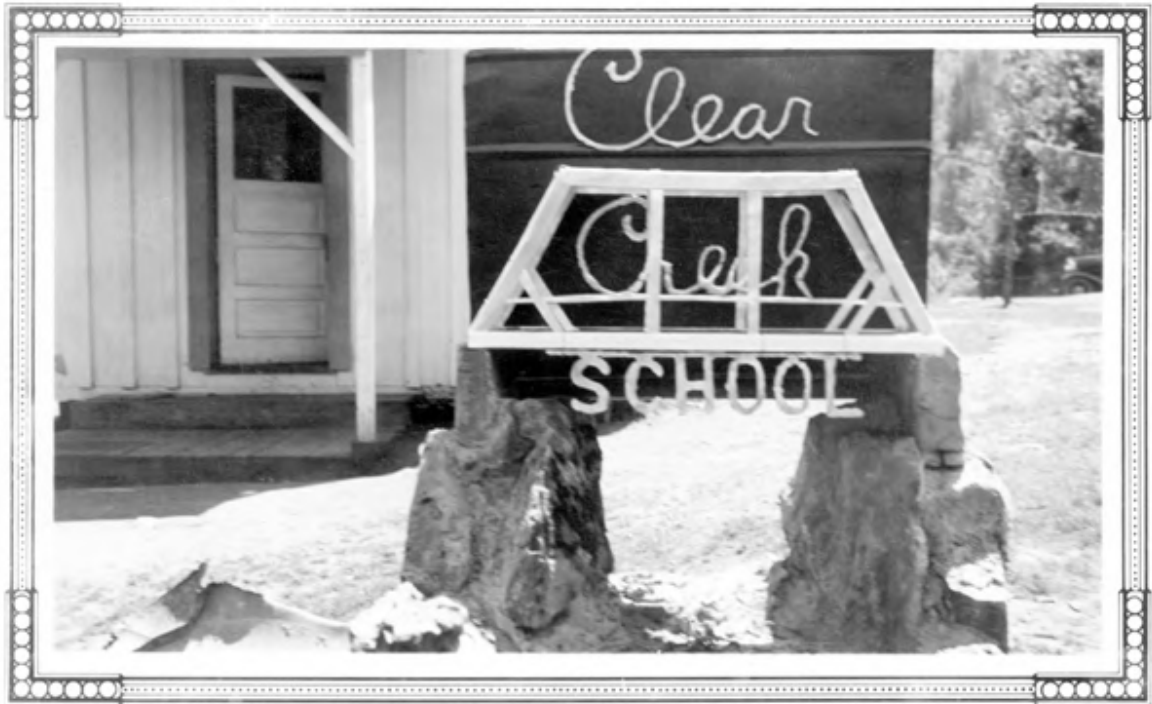
Established: February 7, 1922 – Territory taken from Happy Camp School District, boundaries described (12-397)
