

## **Cottage Grove School District**

**(Also see Dillon School)**

It is probable that the Cottage Grove School District and the Dillon School District are one and the same. Originally the school was called Dillon. A post office named Cottage Grove was established in the area between 1878 and 1893; hence the school became known as the Cottage Grove School (District).

In 1900 the Cottage Grove (Dillon) District was lapsed and added to the Happy Camp School District.

In 1912 the lapsed Cottage Grove (Dillon) School District was re-established as the Dillon District.

The records show that in 1899-1900 the teacher at Cottage Grove (Dillon) was Wm.A. Kleaver, "with an attendance of less than five."
