# Siskiyou Union High School District COVID-19 Phased Reopening Plan

*SUHSD has aligned this Phased Reopening Plan with the Siskiyou County Phased Reopening Plan and the State of California [Blueprint for a Safer Economy Dashboard](#). The district will move between steps in alignment with the State Dashboard and in consideration of COVID-19 cases in our schools.*
