Forks of Salmon Elementary School Petition for Transfer of Territory

Mr. Allan Carver reviewed the Forks of Salmon Elementary School lapsation process. He stated that the Petition for Transfer of Territory had been received and that the County Committee has held two public hearings relating to the petition on November 2, 2022. One public hearing was held at Junction Elementary and the second at Forks of Salmon Elementary School. Mr. Bennett asked Mr. Carver for his recommendation. Mr. Carver stated the statutes call for a compelling reason and he did not find a compelling reason to approve the petition. He noted that the lapsation of Forks of Salmon Elementary is still in motion. Mr. Carver recommended that the county committee deny the Petition for Transfer of Territory.

Dr. Enos moved to deny the Petition for Transfer of Territory initiated by a 25% petition of registered voters in the Forks of Salmon Elementary School District and Scott Valley Unified School District. Mrs. Duchi seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.
