Plan Descriptions

A description of how parents, teachers, and school staff were involved in the development of the plan.

Stakeholders meetings were held including all staff, teachers, and parents via zoom. We discussed the allowable uses of the funds and the needs of our students. We also surveyed all stakeholders to gather further input for those that were not able to attend the zoom meeting. Input was requested from each stakeholder group and solicited ideas for the best use of the funds to meet the students' needs.

A description of how students will be identified and the needs of students will be assessed.

We will use their progress towards meeting their IEP goals as a means of identifying students that might need additional learning time and supplemental instruction. Social Emotional Needs will be evaluated through observations and interactions with staff, teachers, behaviorists, school psychologists, etc. We will assess student needs for social emotional and other integrated supports through daily observations and interactions.

A description of how parents and guardians of students will be informed of the opportunities for supplemental instruction and support.

Parents and/or guardians will be contacted by teacher via phone and follow it up through an email or letter mailed home. Tutoring times will be set up ahead of time to give parents ample opportunity to adjust schedules and arrange transportation.

A description of the LEA's plan to provide supplemental instruction and support.

All Stakeholders agreed that tutoring opportunities beyond the normal extended school year would greatly beneficial. We will provide a Behavior Aide and a Behaviorist to help support students struggling in that area. Credit Recovery will also be provided for those students near graduation. An additional Crisis Prevention Intervention trainer will added. A Diagnostic and Benchmark Assessment Program will be purchased in order to help monitor student progress. Additional Mental Health Professional Development will be provided to help with both social emotional and mental health needs. A Professional Development will be provided for both staff and teachers.
