## RESOLUTION 21-22-01

### REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OR INSUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

Whereas, the governing board of Siskiyou County Office of Education, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on September 15, 2021, at 6 p.m., which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

Whereas, the governing board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places with the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

Whereas, the Board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

Whereas, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional material were provided to all students, including English learners, in the Siskiyou County Office of Education, and:

Whereas, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each student, including each English learner, has a standards-aligned textbook and/or instructional materials to use in class and to take home, which may include material in a digital format but shall not include photocopied sheets from only a portion of a textbook or instructional materials copied to address a shortage, and;

Whereas, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course within the Siskiyou County Office of Education have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycle, and;

Whereas, textbooks or instructional materials in core curriculum subjects should be aligned with state academic content standards adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to Education Code 60605 and/or the Common Core Standards adopted pursuant to Education Code 60605.8;

Whereas, sufficient standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks were provided to each student, including each English learner in the following subjects:

- **Mathematics**
- **English/Language Arts**
- **Science**
- **History/Social Science**

**School Special Day Class for Emotionally Disabled Youth  
Standards-Based Instructional Materials Sufficiency Rationale**

We have completed an inventory of instructional materials used at the Special Day Class for Emotionally Disabled Youth which indicates that the program has established content standards-based curriculum in all subject areas for grades K through 12. We have purchased textbooks that are state adopted or meet the content standards.

- Mathematics-(see attached list of adopted textbooks and instructional materials)
- Science-(see attached list of adopted textbooks and instructional materials)
- History/Social Science-(see attached list of adopted textbooks and instructional materials)
- English/Language Arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program-(see attached list of adopted textbooks and instructional materials)

Whereas, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in health classes and;

Therefore, it is resolved that for the 2020/2021 school year, the Siskiyou County Office of Education has provided each student with sufficient standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.

Middle and High School Emotionally Disturbed Special Day Classes  
Standards Based Instructional Materials  
Sufficiency Resolution

An inventory of the educational materials used in the Middle/High School Emotionally Disturbed Special Day Classes (ED/SDC) indicates that the program has established content standards based curriculum in all subject areas in grades 6 through 12. The program has purchased textbooks that are state adopted or meet the state content standards. The programs will continue to select and purchase standards based Science, History/Social Science, Math, English/Language Arts, and Health textbooks for grades 6 through 12.

**English Language Arts**

Currently the middle/high school ED/SDC program has the following:

Garlic Press Straight Forward English Series. This intervention series is designed to address specific English skills, including parts of speech, grammar, capitalization and punctuation. This curriculum is not aligned to state standards. The Board has approved this intervention curriculum for the English class.

Houghton Mifflin Literary Readers levels 4 through 6, including Success For All materials for all levels. This reading series is state adopted.

Holt Elements of Literature Introductory through Sixth courses for 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades. The Introductory and 1<sup>st</sup> course, for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade, are state adopted. The Board has approved these texts.

## **Math**

Currently the program has the following:

Key Curriculum Press Key to Algebra. This text addresses the state standards. The board has approved this text.

Glencoe/McGraw-Hill Algebra 1. This text addresses the state standards. The board has approved this text.

AGS Publishing Pre-Algebra. This text addresses the state standards. The board has approved this text.

AGS Publishing Geometry and Algebra 1. These texts address the state standards. The board has approved this text.

Saxon Publishing Company Math books for grades 3 through 6 (Saxon 54, 65, 76, and 87), which are state adopted.

McGraw-Hill Pre-Algebra Step By Step. This is an intervention text that addresses the state standards. The board has approved this text.

## **Science**

### **High School**

AGS Publishing Earth Science, Biology and Physical Science texts that are aligned to state standards. The Board has approved these texts.

The program has purchased Glencoe Mc-Graw-Hill Science Voyages Red, Green and Blue for use in the middle school grades. This series is state adopted.

The program is currently using Steck-Vaughn Basic Science for Living and Globe Book Company Science Workshop Series for Earth Science, Life Science, Physical Science and Biology as supplements for our high school level courses. These are intervention materials that are not aligned to state standards. The board has approved these texts.

## **History/Social Science:**

### **High School**

Currently the program is using Steck-Vaughn, Scholastic Fearon Education, Globe, and Heath Social Studies as supplemental texts for middle and high school History/Social Science courses, and Steck-Vaughn Decisions for Health, and AGS Discover Skills for Life for the ninth Grade Health/Social Studies course. These intervention texts are not aligned to state standards. The board has approved these texts.

AGS Publishing texts for US History, World History, and Economics. These texts are aligned to state standards. The Board has approved these texts.

McDougal Littell California Middle School Social Studies Series. This is a state adopted text.

The program has purchased Economics and US Government by Jamestown Education. They are state adopted texts.
