

## CONDITIONAL ADMISSION TO SCHOOL UNTIL REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS ARE COMPLETE

Your child has been admitted to school on the condition that he/she will continue to receive the missing immunizations when the next dose is due. The due date for each immunization is determined by the California Conditional Admission Immunization Schedule (see back of this form). Please ensure that your child receives the next in the series of immunizations before the exclusion date listed in the box next to the required immunization. If the school does not have a record of your child having received the missing immunization by the due date listed, they will not be able to attend school. Your child can return to school as soon as he/she has received the missing immunization dose(s). Absences due to lack of immunizations are not excused.
