

French Creek School District

The district was formed in 1899. The school was located approximately 5.5 miles up French Creek from the Junction of the Etna-Callahan Road and French Creek Road. No trace of the school house can be found.

Miss Elizabeth An Neilon was the teacher in 1899. School was held for a six-month term with 20 pupils in attendance.

The district was lapsed in 1927 and probably was attached to Douglas School District.
