

Hovey Gulch School District

The Hovey Gulch School District was established in 1885. The school was located 1.8 miles north of the Hovey Gulch Road from the intersection of the Upper Little Shasta Road and the Hovey Gulch Road.

The school house still stands and is not being used for any purpose. The 1899 records in the County Superintendent of Schools office show that Mr. A.G.W. Davis was the teacher. School was held for eight months with 17 pupils in attendance. In 1930 the district was annexed to Foothill District.

April 5, 1902 – Territory taken from Hovey Gulch and added to Foot Hill, description given (6-638)

April 3, 1905 – Boundary change rejected (7-170)

April 5, 1920 – Part of Hovey Gulch annexed to Foot Hill School District (12-136, 137)

May 9, 1934 – Authorization to sell school house (16-345)
