

Kidder Creek School District

The district was formed in 1880. The school house was located approximately three miles north of Greenview on the old road between Greenview and Fort Jones. No trace of the building can be found. In 1899 the teacher was Miss Sierra Shields. School was half for seven and a half months with 30 pupils in attendance.

As the farm families increased and decreased in the area, the district was often suspended and then re-established. Finally, in 1950 the district was discontinued and was probably annexed to the Greenview District.
