

Klamath River Union

Klamath River Union School District was formed in 1951 and included the Scott River District, Horse Creek District, the Rocky Mountain District, and the Riverside District.

The school is located on the south side of the Klamath River, 26 miles down the river on Highway 96 (Klamath River Road) from its junction with the State Route 263 (Old Highway 99).

Reference in board of Supervisors minutes:

Established: September 18, 1951 – Unionization of Scott River and Horse Creek (to form Klamath River Union) (22-23)

November 6, 1952 – Sale of bonds laid over (22-309)

November 18, 1952 – Issue of bonds (22-316)

January 7, 1953 – Awarding bonds (22-345)
