

Lake School District

The Lake District was established July 17, 1888. The school house was located three miles southwest of Dorris in the vicinity of Buckaroo Flats. No trace of the building remains.

In 1899, Miss Blanche Whiting was the teacher. School was held for a six month term with 12 students in attendance. In 1902 the district was lapsed and made part of the Sunnyside School District.

Reference in board of Supervisors minutes:

January 13, 1885 – Original petition for formation rejected (4-35)

July 9, 1885 – Petition for formation again denied (4-66)

Established: July 17, 1888 – Established, boundaries described (4-347)

July 8, 1902 – District lapsed and made part of Sunnyside School District (7-21)

April 6, 1903 – Authorization for County Superintendent to dispose of the property of the lapsed Lake school District (7-88)

July 27, 1903 – Deed to sell Lake School District school house executed (7-100)
