

Little Klamath School District

The Little Klamath School District was established in 1889. In 1900 it was lapsed and annexed to the Lake View School District. The latter district was formed in 1891.

The location of the Little Klamath school house cannot be determined. However, we believe that the Rheet school house was originally the school of Little Klamath. When Lake View was formed, two years after the Little Klamath District, the school was called Lakeview and eventually the entire Little Klamath District was annexed to Lake View.
