

May School District

The May School District was formed January 6, 1910. The school was located approximately six miles south of Dorris and four miles north of Macdoel on highway 97. The Southern Pacific Railroad ran past the school and the area was known as the May Siding.

The people of the district were connected with the railroad or the lumbering industry. At the siding, lumber and logs were loaded onto trains and freight was unloaded. The siding has since been abandoned but many of the old structures still stand.

The one and only teacher, since school was only held for one year, was Alice E. Taylor. In 1912 the school was lapsed and added to the Macdoel District.
