

## **Mill Creek School District**

### **(Scott Valley)**

This district was established in 1900. The school was located approximately three miles up the Quartz Valley Road from the junction of the Scott River Road and Quartz Valley Road. No trace of the school house remains.

In 1900, Miss Ida Erno was the teacher. School was held for seven months with 31 pupils attending. The district was lapsed in 1937 and the territory was divided between Quartz Valley and the Meamber Districts.

January 7, 1901 – Boundaries re-defined (6-554)

August 19, 1910 – Petition for suspension denied (8-250)

August 19, 1911 – District suspended (8-485)

February 5, 1912 – Territory taken from Quartz Valley School District and added to Mill School District (9-90-1)

July 1, 1935 – District suspended (17-81)

August 3, 1937 – District lapsed and territory divided between Quartz Valley and Meamber School Districts (18-37)
