

Mill School District

The Mill School District was established in 1889. The school house was located at Oak Street and South Mount Shasta Boulevard in the present town of Mt. Shasta. The Mountainair Motel now stands on the site. The district served the families of the lumber mill workers. In 1898, the Berryvale and Mill School Districts were consolidated under the name of Berryvale.

Reference in board of Supervisors minutes:

Established: May 11, 1889 – Boundaries described (4-432)

April 4, 1889 – Berryvale and Mill were consolidated under the name of Sisson (6-189)

May 7, 1898 – Above order amended to read: the Berryvale and Mill School Districts are consolidated under the name of Berryvale.
