

Moffett Creek School District

The Moffett Creek District was established May 2, 1870. The school house was located on the old Yreka-Fort Jones Road. At the bottom of Forest Mountain just before crossing Moffett Creek, turn right on the old road and proceed approximately a half mile. A private residence is now built on this site and no remains of the school exist.

In 1899, school was held for eight months with 69 pupils in attendance. Mr. Robert J. Willard was the teacher. The district was lapsed and annexed to the Lincoln District in 1942.

Established: May 2, 1870 – Boundaries given (3-89)

October 7, 1889 – Tax election (4-479)

July 8, 1941 – District suspended (19-16)

June 19, 1942 – District lapsed and annexed to Lincoln District which is unionized with Fort Jones (19-96)
