

Pebble School District

(Also see McCloud)

The first school in the McCloud area was called the Warm Castle School. It was located south of McCloud at Soda Springs (approximately a half mile south of the present golf course). In May 1889 a legal school district was formed called Pebble District using the old school at Warm Castle.

By 1910-1911, the attendance had decreased to the extent that the district could no longer be maintained. On April 29, 1911, the Pebble School District and the neighboring McCloud School District were combined to form the present McCloud Union District.

Established: May 11, 1889 – Boundaries described (4-432)

August 20, 1910 – Algomah District lapsed and made part of Pebble (8-251)

April 29, 1911 – Pebble and McCloud School Districts combined to McCloud Union School District (8-421)

August 7, 1928 – Pebble (attendance center) was suspended and then re-established (15-101)

August 6, 1929 – Pebble suspended and re-established (15-205)

July 6, 1933 – Pondsosa School District lapsed and annexed to pebble District (16-259)
