

## **Pondosa School District**

Pondosa was a logging town 26 miles east of McCloud. The school was located approximately three miles northeast of Highway 89 in the community.

The Pondosa District was established in 1925. On November 3, 1925, part of the McCloud District was taken to form the Pondosa District. School was held there from 1925 to 1933 when, the loggers having left, the district was lapsed and annexed to the Pebble District, which in turn was made part of the McCloud District.

The school is still at Pondosa and has been used off and on as an attendance center of the McCloud School District.

Established: November 3, 1925 – Established from part of McCloud, boundaries described (14-44)

July 6, 1933 – Lapsed and annexed to Pebble School District
