

Redd School District

The Redd District was established in 1911. The school house was located approximately seven and a half miles east on the Bryant-Willow Creek Road from the junction with the Montague-Ager Road. No remains of the building can be found.

The first teacher was Clara M. Davies. School was held for a six month term. The district lapsed in 1930 and the territory was annexed to the Foothill District.

Reference in board of Supervisors minutes:

Established: January 3, 1911 – Boundaries described, created out of territory from the Foothill School District (8-375)

August 3, 1925 – District suspended (14-19)

September 8, 1925 – District re-established (14-26)

August 6, 1929 – District suspended (15-205)

August 5, 1930 – District lapsed and territory annexed to the Foothill District (15-312)
