

## **Rheet (Rhett) School District**

The Rheet Lake School District was established in 1913. The school house was located on the Dorris-Brownell Road, approximately four and a half miles south of its junction with the State Line Road. It was built on the west slope of Sheepy Ridge. Nothing remains of the school house.

Two teachers served at this school in the first year. Amy Dole taught for three and a half months and Cora L. Miller taught the remaining months. In 1925, the district was lapsed and the territory was added to the Oklahoma District.
