

Rollin School District

The Rollin District was established April 4, 1903. This school was located approximately four miles up Eddy Gulch on the Sawyers Bar-Forks of Salmon Road. Miss Ida Erno was the first teacher and school was held for a six month term with 16 pupils in attendance.

At the time of formation there were a number of miners and their families along Eddy Gulch. As the mines were worked out, the attendance at the school slowly decreased. The district was lapsed August 7, 1917, and the school house sold. Although there are no clear records, the district probably was added to the Sawyers Bar District.
