

Rose School District

The district was formed in 1901. The site of the school house lies on the right side of the road, three miles up Greenhorn Creek from the junction of Greenhorn Road and interstate 5. No remains of the school house are visible.

Miss Sarah J. Richardson was the first teacher. School was held for seven months with 20 pupils attending. The district was lapsed in 1927, and the territory was divided between the Greenhorn and Yreka Districts.

December 7, 1915 – Part of district taken to form Cherry Creek District (10-51)

August 2, 1920 – Suspended (12-176)

August 2, 1927 – Lapsed and territory added to Greenhorn and Yreka Districts (14-249)
