

Russianville School District

The Russianville School District was established in 1903. The school house was located east of the mouth of the Little North Fork of the Salmon River, and four miles west of Sawyers Bar on the Sawyers Bar-Forks of Salmon Road. It was near the public campground called “Red Banks”.

Miss C.W. Atkinson was one of the early teachers in this district (1907). There were 11 pupils attending during her career there. In 1914, the district was merged with the Sawyers Bar School District.
