

Scott Valley School District

(See Fort Jones)

The Scott Valley School District was established in 1885. In 1893, the name was changed to Fort Jones School District. The school houses, etc. described in the Fort Jones section are the same for Scott Valley School District.

Scott Valley was first explored by Hudson Bay trapper. Later, in 1850, a group of miners led by Captain Scott panned for gold in the valley and along the Scott River. Scott Valley, Scott River, and Scott Bar were named after Captain Scott.

Record of boundaries may be found in records of the office of the County Superintendent of Schools.
