

Sisson School District

In 1916, the Berryvale School District was renamed Sisson School District (Refer to Berryvale for history). In 1925, the name was changed again to Mount Shasta Union District.

Berryvale was renamed Sisson in 1887 for J.H. Sisson, who had previously laid out the town site when the railroad line came though the area. Mr. Sisson developed a large tourist stop there for passengers in the Southern Pacific Railroad.

Established: May 1, 1916 – Berryvale District renamed Sisson (6-189)

April 7, 1925 – Petition for change of name (13-362)

May 5, 1925 – Name Sisson change to Mount Shasta Union (13-380)
