

## **South Fork School District**

The South Fork District was established in 1964. The school house was located approximately three miles above the junction of the Etna-Callahan Road and the Callahan-Cecilville Road. The area was called French Flat. It was the first school in the Callahan area. The school house is still standing on the Bouvier Ranch, its original site. The building is being used as a “junk House”.

It was on and about French Flat that, at one time, over three hundred miners had their cabins and camps. There was also a group of three to five hundred Chinese working as miners in the area.
