

## **Strawberry Valley School District**

**(See Berryvale)**

Strawberry Valley, later called Sisson and finally Mount Shasta, was first located by John Sires and John C. Gordon, who named it for the abundance of wild strawberries growing there.

Apparently, as the settlement grew, a school district was established. On May 3, 1870, this district was formally recognized by the Board of Supervisors. No description is given of the district or the location of the school, if there was one. It is likely that this district was absorbed by Berryvale District.
