

Sullroy School District

This is the only district in Siskiyou County of which the author was unable to find any trace.

Although the district was established in 1867 by the Board of Supervisors, it apparently never actually materialized. The description of the boundaries read, "From the ridge south of Edgewood to the Shasta County line" (?). As far as can be determined from long time residents of the area and from the lack of records, we believe that the district, although legally formed, "never existed".

Probably what happened is that before this district could actually start school, portions of it independently started schools of their own, such as Berryvale, Summit, Spring, etc. lying in the southern portion of the county, and the original district was forgotten.
