

Tamarack School District

Tamarack was established in 1915. The school was located five miles from the town of Bray on the present Tennant Road. The main line of the Southern Pacific Railroad passed nearby. It served the families of the railroad workers and area ranchers. No sign of the school house remains.

The first teacher was Nellie M. Weston. School was held for six months the first year. Although no clear reference is available, this district was probably included in the Tennant District.
