

## Union School District

The Union School District was formed in 1866. The school house was located at the point of Smith hill approximately one and a half miles northeast of Etna on the Scott Valley-Island Road. No remains of the school house can be found. The district was suspended and although no formal minute of action are available, the territory was probably annexed to the Etna District.

### Reference in board of Supervisors minutes:

Established: August 6, 1866 – Territory taken from the Rough and Ready District, boundaries described (2-553)

August 3, 1868 – Boundary change (3-13)

November 3, 1923 – Petition for boundary change laid over (13-166)

December 4, 1923 – Boundary change (13-170)

July 6, 1951 – District suspended (21-482)

Note: Although the Board of Supervisor minutes reflect the district as suspended in 1951, records in the office of the County Superintendent show that the district was unionized with Etna in 1907-1908.
