

Vineland School District

The Vineland School District was established in 1868. The school house, a one-story brick building, is located approximately eight miles south of Yreka on Old Highway 99 and one mile north of the intersection of A-12 and Interstate 5. The building has since been used many times as a residence.

In 1899, Miss Clara B. Burrows was the teachers. School was held for an eight month period with 23 pupils in attendance. The district was annexed to the Greenhorn District in 1929.
