

Weed Union School District

The present Weed Union District is the result of the union of the Mount Shasta District and the Summit District called Summit Union School District. In 1921, the Summit Union District's name changed to Weed Union School District. The location of the school house of the Weed District is the site of the present school (see Summit District for more information).

Established: January 3, 1921 – Summit Union School District hereafter called the Weed Union District (12-239)

April 16, 1928 – Matter of issuing bonds (15-41)

May 8, 1928 – Matter of bonds (15-53)

May 6, 1930 – Matter of bonds (15-274)

June 3, 1930 – Matter of bonds (15-282)
