

## **Wheatland (Wheatfield) School District**

The Wheatland School District was established in 1891. The school house was located approximately four miles north of Gazelle on the Old West Side Road. It stood in the middle of a grain field, hence the name. No trace of the building remains.

In 1899, Miss K. Blanch Taylor was the teacher. School was held for seven and half months with 20 pupils in attendance. Although no official notation can be found, the district was probably annexed to Gazelle around 1946.
